From 2003 to 2008 she collaborated with CPO-Piemonte (Centre for Epidemiology and Cancer Prevention) on a project for smoking prevention and cessation in Piedmont Region.

Her main research interests are currently focused on health promotion in childhood and adolescents, as member of the both national and international groups that manages HBSC (Health Behavior in School-aged Children, www.hbsc.org), with a particular focus on risk behaviors.

Other fields of research are the epidemiology of healthcare-associated infections; the management of patients with type 2 diabetes; investigation of treatments, discomfort and end-of-life critical decisions in patients with advanced-stage dementia.
